



# Lone Peak High School Drivers Education 2009-2010



## How to Register for Drivers Education at Lone Peak High School

- 1) If you are planning to take Drivers Education during the school year, complete the below LPHS Registration Form and drop it off along with your receipt for paying for the class at the Lone Peak High School Counseling Center. You may pay for the class at the Lone Peak financial office or pay on-line at [www.myschoolfees.com](http://www.myschoolfees.com).
- 2) All students must acquire and show proof of having a Learners Permit on the first day of class. No student will be allowed without a permit. This may be done through the Driver's License Division.
- 3) If you choose to take drivers education during the summer, you must pay the fee on-line at [www.myschoolfees.com](http://www.myschoolfees.com). Visit the LPHS website at: <http://lonepeak.alpinedistrict.org/> for more information about summer Drivers Education.

The below options will be available for students for the 2009 – 2010 school year. The fee for Drivers Education is \$90 during the school year and \$135 during the summer. Fees include classroom instruction, range, and road driving.

### **Summer School**

Summer Drivers Education classes begin on June 1. For more information about taking Drivers Education during the summer, please visit the Lone Peak High School website at: <http://lonepeak.alpinedistrict.org/>.

### **Before School (6:00 a.m. - 7:30 a.m.)**

This class will be offered on B-days. Students will meet every other day throughout the quarter.

### **After School (2:30 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.)**

This class will be offered every Tuesday or Wednesday after school for the entire quarter. Classes will be from 2:30 - 6:00 p.m.

### **During Lunch (12:15 p.m. - 12:45 p.m.)**

This option will be offered as an independent study class. It will require the same amount of work, assignments, and tests as the other options; however, the work will be done at home at their own pace. Students will then take the tests during lunch period. They must finish the class within the quarter, but they can take the tests throughout the quarter at their own pace.

### **On-line Independent Study and Private Companies**

In addition to the above options, students may choose to complete the course requirement independently on-line through Electronic High School at: [www.ehs.com](http://www.ehs.com). In addition, students may use local businesses that offer drivers education instruction. There is no fee for taking the course independently through Electronic High School (EHS); however, if a student chooses to do the range instruction through Lone Peak High School, there will be a \$90 fee. Fees will vary for taking the course through private companies.

Our Drivers Education Department will organize class requests and schedule students for classes taken at the high school. Students will be informed during the summer which section and term they have been registered for.

As a reminder, students must have their Learners Permit in order to drive. They may get their permit one year prior to their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday. They must have their permit for **at least** six months prior to receiving their license.

## **Commonly Asked Questions about Driver's Education**

### **How do I sign up?**

Go to the Lone Peak Finance Office and pay the \$90 fee. Bring the receipt to the Counseling Office and fill out the Registration Form. Then sign up for the class and the quarter.

### **How do I pay?**

Go to the Lone Peak Finance Office and pay the \$90 fee or pay online at: [www.myschoolfees.com](http://www.myschoolfees.com)

### **Do I need to have a permit before I take the class?**

A driver's permit is required to take the class. You must have it for 6 months before you can get your license.

### **Where do I get a permit and a Driver's Handbook?**

Go to the Driver's License Division on 8<sup>th</sup> North in Orem or on Minuteman Drive in Bluffdale. You must take two forms of Utah ID like a phone bill or a power bill. You will take a computer quiz to get your permit. You can get the Driver's Handbook at the Driver's License Division or from any Driver's Ed teacher.

### **What times and dates are classes offered?**

Classes are offered before school on B-days, after school on Tuesdays, or as Independent Study.

### **Where and when do I meet for class?**

If you sign up for before school, you will meet with Lyle Mangum in the trailer room 904 on the first Bday of the quarter.

If you sign up for Tuesdays after school, you will meet with Scott Birrell in room 133 on the first Tuesday of the quarter.

If you sign up for Wednesdays after school, you will meet with Danny Schoonover in the trailer room 909 on the first Wednesday of the quarter.

If you sign for Independent Study, meet with Shauna Kay in room 700 during lunch on the first day of the quarter.

### **Are the classes graded and given credit?**

This class is a graded class and you will receive .25 credit for passing the class. This class will also effect your GPA. If you choose to drop the class after two weeks into the quarter, you will receive an "F" for the quarter and have to pay again to take the class.

### **Can you miss any days of class?**

In order to receive credit you must attend 27 hours of class during the quarter.

Independent study is not required to attend classes.

### **How do I sign up for range?**

You will sign up for range orientation and range during class with your teacher. If you are taking Independent Study or Electronic High School, you need to go to room 700 and sign up with Shauna Kay.

### **Where do I meet for range?**

At American Fork High School just south of the tennis courts and football field.

### **What if I can't make the range dates?**

You will sign up for the dates you can attend. You must be able to attend all four days from either 3-5, 5-7, or 7-9. You must give us a 48 hour notice if you can not attend, so please try and clear your schedule for those four days. If you don't show up for range, you will be moved to the range at the end of the year.

### **When will my road instructor drive me?**

Your road instructor may or may not be your classroom instructor, but you can find out your road instructor from your classroom teacher. Our goal is to drive you before your birthday. Road instructors will contact you and set up a driving day and time. Also, feel free to contact your road instructor to set up a time with them.

### **What if I need to change the quarter or time in which I signed up?**

Contact the counseling office and have them make the change for you.

### **What if I failed the class or want to change the class after it has already started?**

You have two weeks to drop the class and sign up for a different quarter, otherwise you will pay
