Students must meet **Tuesday, June 1st** for instruction. Meet in room 700 at Lone Peak High School.
You must complete the following before you get your license:

1. Driving Permit for six months
2. 40 hours with a parent (10 hours must be at night)
3. Successful completion of Driver's Education class
4. Completion of the following:
 - Range Orientation: Two hours @ AF driving range (**May 19 or 20**)
 - Range: Two hour each day (Monday-Thursday @ range) (**June 7-10 or June 21-24**)
 - Road: Six hours with a road instructor

All work and tests must be completed by: **August 3, 2010**

Please acquire a driver's permit at the Driver's License Division (DLD) before taking the class. You must have this permit for **6 months** before receiving your driver's license.

Drivers Education .25 credit

This course is designed to fulfill the state requirements for a driver's license under the present Utah State Law. Each student must complete a minimum of 30 hours of classroom instruction, in addition to a minimum of eight hours of range work, six hours of road work, and 40 hours of practice driving with parents (10 of which have to be at night or early morning.) Parents must provide transportation to and from the American Fork Driver Range.

Grading Policy:

Grading Breakdown:

93-100% = A
90-92% = A-
87-89% = B+
83-86% = B
80-82% = B-
77-79% = C+

Below 70% = F (performance does not indicate sufficient effort to warrant a release. Repeating the class will be necessary.)

Students should complete approximately half of the work by mid-term. Grades will be input for mid-term so students will know where they are so far in class. If no work has been done, then an "F" will be given for the mid-term grade
